Installer Re-Certification is now available on-line!

You now have two options to complete your re-certification: on-line testing or mail-in testing. To become re-certified for a period of four (4) years, a Re-Certification Test must be taken. The re-certification test will be self-study and is an open-book exam. An InstallationMastersTM Training Manual may be purchased if you are unable to locate your copy.
