First full week in April is recognized as Window Safety Week

This observance is held annually during the first full week in April. This year Window Safety Week is April 3 - 9 and is designed to heighten the awareness of what parents and caregivers can do to help keep their family safer from the risks of window falls or injuries in the home, and how they can use their windows for emergency escape and rescue purposes.

Tips to share:

- Doors serve as the primary exits. Windows provide a secondary means of escape from a burning home or for other emergencies.
- Keep furniture - or anything children can climb on - away from windows.
- Insect screens are meant to keep insects out, not to prevent falls from windows.
- Falling through an insect screen, open window or glass can be fatal or cause serious injury.
